






Warm and Wet antecedent Winter/Spring Seasons

From Monsoon Outlook: 6/12/24


Odds favor <u>Above Normal Temperatures</u> and <u>Below Normal Rainfall</u>; Possible early false start followed by normal onset; historical evidence supports more erratic placement of Monsoon Ridge and increased inverted trough activity from La Niña. We'll likely finish somewhere wetter than 2020/2023 but drier than 2021/2022.





June 2024 Mean Position








Monsoon Moisture Tracker



Well Above Normal Temperatures and Rainfall for most of AZ









July-August 1991-2020 Mean




July-August 2024 Mean Position







July was Hot and Active Across Portions of AZ...

Well Above Normal Temperatures Prevail






Historic June-September Heat!



Phoenix Summer Heat Stats:

- 113 Day Streak of 100°F+ High Temperatures
 - (May 27th September 16th)
- 18 Daily High Temperature Records Tied/Broken
- 28 Daily Warm Low Temperature Records Tied/Broken
- Total 110°F+ High Days: 62
- Total 115°F+ High Days: 12
- Total 90°F+ Low Days: 39
- Average Summer Temperature: 98.3°F
 - (Jun: 97.0°F, Jul: 101.1°F, Aug: 98.7°F, Sep: 94.6°F)
- Latest Observed Instance of 110°F (Oct 7th) and 115°F (Sept 28th)
- All Time High Temperature for Sep. (117°F, 29th) and Oct. (113°F, 6th)
- 21 Day Streak of Daily High Temperature Records Broken (National Record)












Monsoon Rainfall as Percent of Normal

Central AZ Accumulated Mean Monsoon Rainfall - Years of Note (297 Index Gages)




Average Summer Thunderstorm (Monsoon) Season Rainfall - Past 44 Years



Flood Control District of Maricopa County ALERT Rain Gages






