Final Codebook

Includes text of questions asked with values recorded for responses.

Also includes codes developed for open-ended items. Note that we allowed for several responses for open-ends; the dataset shows the variable repeated with a _a, _b suffix.

Variables which have been computed are included here for reference; only items that look like questions were asked of respondents.

Not all open-end items have been coded; there were a number that only a small subset of respondents were asked (due to skip pattern) or where the responses did not group well enough to summarize. These are available as separate files.

The survey was administered using a Computer Assisted Interviewing system (both phone and face-to-face). There were a number of complex skips based on type of home, problems mentioned, HOA status, etc. The CAI program handled the checks for these "behind the scenes" and that code is not reproduced here. Some critical skips are included and explained in the codebook.
